Situated in the western extreme of Southern Europe, the region is renowned for its lush green hills and wild Atlantic coastline; its ancient traditions; its widely-spoken native language, Galician; its excellent cuisine – and, of course, its music.

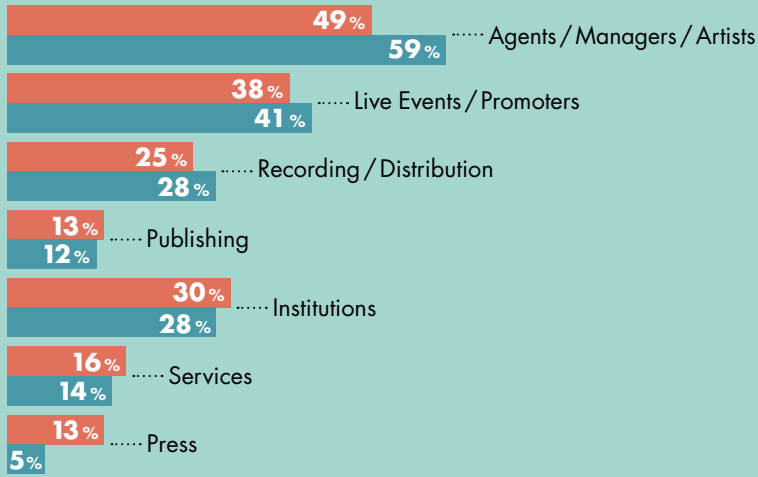
